CRAFT ELECTED TO NATIONAL BOARD OF COUNTY ENGINEERS

Lansing, Mich. – Today, the County Road Association of Michigan announced that Mark A. Craft, P.E. was elected Secretary-Treasurer of the National Association of County Engineers at their 2009 Annual Technical Conference held last week.

The National Association of County Engineers (NACE) is a professional association representing county engineers and professional road managers.
