## **Lenawee County Road Commission manager to lead statewide road association**

LANSING, MI – Scott Merillat, PE, manager of the Lenawee County Road Commission (LCRC), has been elected 2026-2027 president of the County Road Association (CRA) of Michigan. Merillat was elected during the Association’s annual Highway Conference in Lansing and began his term April 1. He served as CRA vice president for 2025-2026.

Merillat has been LCRC managing director since 2010. He began his career in 1994 as LCRC county highway engineer, a role he held until 2000. He then became a co-owner of a local engineering and surveying firm, continuing to work on county road projects as a consultant. Merillat returned to LCRC in 2010.

“I’m honored to serve as president of the CRA Board,” Merillat said. “The Association plays a critical role in advancing Michigan’s county road system, and I look forward to working with my peers across all 83 counties to build on that momentum and strengthen the future of our local roads.”



The 83 members of the County Road Association of Michigan represent the unified voice for a safe and efficient county transportation infrastructure system in Michigan, including appropriate stewardship of the public’s right-of-way in rural and urban Michigan. Collectively, Michigan’s county road agencies manage 75% of all roads in the state, including 90,500 miles of roads and nearly 5,900 bridges. County road agencies also maintain the state’s highway system in 63 counties. Michigan has the nation’s fourth-largest local road system.
