Roads+SM announces endorsements for 2026 November General Election

LANSING, MI — Roads+SM, the political advocacy arm of the County Road Association (CRA) of Michigan, has endorsed 57 House and 26 Senate candidates for the 2026 November General Election.

Roads+SM is a panel of county road leaders and industry stakeholders from across the state who work to advocate for local road issues and supportive candidates from the Lower and Upper Peninsulas. Roads+SM endorses candidates with proven track records, relationships with their road agencies and understanding of the entire road right-of-way system including roads, bridges and adjacent facilities.

“With the August Primary behind us, our Roads+SM trustees reviewed and updated our endorsements for the November General Election, considering the issues most important to county road agencies,” said CRA CEO Denise Donohue, who serves as Roads+SM treasurer. “These candidates represent strong local transportation advocates and leaders from across the state.”

“As dollars from the 2025 Road Funding Package are reaching our road agencies, with the full impact still to come in 2027, we continue to face legislative issues that impact day-to-day operations, from escalating health care costs to winter road responsibilities,” Donohue said. “We look forward to continuing to work with the 103rd Legislature and ensuring that county road agency priorities remain part of the conversation in Lansing.”
