INFORMATION TO BIDDERS

NOTICE TO BIDDERS: Sealed proposals will be received by the Benzie County Road Commission (BCRC) at 11318 Main Street, PO Box 68, Honor, MI 49640 until **9:00 am Wednesday, May 6th, 2026**. All bids will be publicly opened and read at **9:00 am Wednesday, May 6th, 2026** at the Main Office of the Benzie County Road Commission, 11318 Main Street, Honor, MI 49640. Bids shall be in accordance with the specifications obtainable from the road commission office. Bids shall be submitted on the forms provided, in sealed envelopes plainly marked as to the contents, and shall include the name of the bidder. Emailed, faxed, telephoned or texted bids will not be accepted. **Bids sent through the US Mail MUST include the PO Box number. The USPS does not guarantee delivery of our current day’s mail until 11:00 a.m. The US Postal Service does not forward improperly addressed mail; this could result in bids not arriving on time.**

Bids will be tabulated, and a recommendation will be made to the Board of County Road Commissioners at their next regular meeting, tentatively scheduled for May 14th, 2026.

PRE-QUALIFICATIONS - Bidders shall be pre-qualified by the Michigan Department of Transportation or have available, upon request, three references from previous work experience including the company name, address, phone, and contact person.

SCOPE OF WORK – The work to be completed includes crushing and processing approximately 2,300 cubic yards of existing concrete material at the Thompson Pit into MDOT 21AA aggregate into 1¼ - . The contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment, and materials necessary to complete the work.

BID REQUIREMENTS – The undersigned has examined the location(s) of the work described herein and is fully informed as to the nature of the work and conditions relating to its performance and understands the quantities shown are approximate and are subject to either increase or decrease.

The undersigned hereby proposes to furnish all necessary equipment, tools, apparatus, and other means of construction, do all of the work, furnish all materials except as otherwise specified herein; and, for the unit prices named in the **attached Itemized Bid Form**, complete the work herein described in strict accordance with the plans and the requirements of these bid documents. The undersigned further proposes to perform extra work (for items that are not included with the itemized form) that may be authorized by the BCRC. Compensation for the extra work will be made on the basis of an agreed upon unit price prior to performing the extra work.

BID WITHDRAWAL – No bid may be withdrawn for a period of 60 calendar days after bid opening.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS - The contractor shall at all times exercise extreme care and shall hold the Benzie County Road Commission harmless from any claims or damages. The successful bidder shall provide proof of insurance for General Liability, Auto Liability, and Worker’s Compensation and shall name Benzie County Road Commission as an additional insured for general liability. Certificates shall be on file with the Road Commission prior to the start of any work.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE – The contractor shall provide a construction schedule upon request. Work shall be coordinated with the Road Commission’s preparation schedule. All work shall be confined to daylight hours. No work shall be performed on holidays, as determined by the BCRC. The contractor shall give the BCRC Superintendent or Inspector twenty-four (24) hours’ notice prior to beginning work at any location.

TAXES – The contractor shall pay all Michigan Sales and Use taxes.

SUBCONTRACTING - The approval of the Road Commission shall be obtained prior to any substantial work being subcontracted. The contractor shall provide proof that any subcontractor has sufficient equipment, insurance and personnel to properly complete any item of work within the specified time.

START DATE – All projects will be ready to begin in accordance with the Michigan Department of Transportation Construction Manual, and weather dependent. Unless noted in the special notes.

COMPLETION DATE – July 31, 2026, unless otherwise determined and approved by the Benzie County Road Commission.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES – Liquidated damages of \$200 per calendar day will be assessed after the completion date shown for project until it is completed.

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SPECIAL NOTES:

1. Material must meet MDOT 21AA specifications.
2. Contractor shall reprocess any material not meeting specifications at their expense.
3. Final material shall be stockpiled neatly.
4. Crusher must utilize a minimum of two (2) magnets to remove metal with 1 on the finished product.

The BCRC will not pay the Contractor for the work performed on the project until after the inspections are completed, corrective work is completed (if necessary), and the project is accepted by the BCRC.
