**Barry County Road Commission former manager
receives statewide Distinguished Service Award**

LANSING, MI – Barry County Road Commission (BCRC) former managing director Brad Lamberg, PE, was honored today by the County Road Association (CRA) of Michigan with a Distinguished Service Award at the 2024 CRA Highway Conference in Lansing.

Distinguished Service Awards recognize road agency staff and commissioners who have dedicated their time and service in an outstanding manner to the advancement of the county road and bridge system in Michigan.



Lamberg, a long serving CRA board member and board president in 2014, served as BCRC managing director for 27 years before retiring earlier this year. In addition to his service on the CRA board, Lamberg was also an active member of CRA’s Engineering, Legislative and General Policy committees.

“The work done by Brad significantly impacted Barry County roads and is a shining example for the entire state,” said Denise Donohue, CRA CEO. “His leadership has left Barry County with the best rated road system in the state and his work with CRA, including his decade-plus tenure on the Board, has helped road commissions statewide.”

The 83 members of the County Road Association of Michigan represent the unified voice for a safe and efficient county transportation infrastructure system in Michigan, including appropriate stewardship of the public’s right-of-way in rural and urban Michigan. Collectively, Michigan’s county road agencies manage 75% of all roads in the state, including 90,500 miles of roads and 5,900 bridges. County road agencies also maintain the state’s highway system in 63 counties. Michigan has the nation’s fourth-largest local road system.
