Cass County Road Commission finance director receives statewide Distinguished Service Award

LANSING, MI – Cass County Road Commission (CCRC) finance director Terri Wyman was honored by the County Road Association (CRA) of Michigan with a Distinguished Service Award at the 2025 CRA Highway Conference in Lansing.

Distinguished Service Awards recognize road agency staff and commissioners who have dedicated their time and service in an outstanding manner to the advancement of the county road and bridge system in Michigan.

Wyman has been with the Cass County Road Commission since she graduated high school in 1986. Known as CCRC on-staff “historian,” she started out working the front desk and has dedicated her career to contributing to her community.

“The work done by Terri significantly impacted Cass County,” said Denise Donohue, CRA CEO. “Her dedication has been nothing short of exemplary and is an inspiration to all county road agencies.”

The 83 members of the County Road Association of Michigan represent the unified voice for a safe and efficient county transportation infrastructure system in Michigan, including appropriate stewardship of the public's right-of-way in rural and urban Michigan. Collectively, Michigan's county road agencies manage 75% of all roads in the state, including 90,500 miles of roads and 5,900 bridges.
