Effective 8:00 a.m. Monday, **April 8**, 2019 Seasonal Weight and Speed Restrictions will be continued on the following Leelanau County Roads:

- Amore Road from CR 643 to Popp Road
- Beeman Road
- Birch Point Road
- CR 616 between CR 614 and CR 651
- Gatzke Road west of CR 651
- Grandview Road
- Kasben Road
- Kasson Center Road from Newman Road to County Road 667
- Lincoln Road
- Narlock Road from County Road 667 to Townline Road
- O'Brien Road
- Popp Road from Amore Road to CR 645
- Roubal Road
- Schomberg Road from Gatzke Road to Pit Road
- Setterbo Road from Dumas Road to M-22
- Sylt Road
- Townline Road south of Mountain Road
- Traverse Lake Road
- All county roads signed as "Seasonal Roads" that are not snowplowed during winter

Effective 8:00 am **April 8**, 2019, on all other Leelanau County Roads the Seasonal Weight and Speed Restrictions will be lifted and regular loading under the Bridge Formula will be allowed. Annual (extended) overload permits are not valid until further notice.
